

EXAM RULES

Candidate may take written and oral part of the exam only if the candidate applied for such exam and if the identity of the candidate is confirmed with a personal document containing photo issued by state authority. Slovenian language exam includes written and oral part. Oral part is taken individually (in front of a committee) while the written part is taken in a group with other candidates applying for exam term.

Candidates must attend exam in a timely manner, both for written and oral exam (candidates shall be notified on the date and time of exam in advance).

Candidate missing the written part of the exam may not take the exam.

During the written part of the exam, the candidate may have only writing utensils, valid ID and water on the desk.

During the exam, candidates shall follow the instructions of the exam committee.

Candidates must turn off mobile phones and other electronic devices.

Candidates shall use ballpoint pens (if using pencils, answers must be confirmed with ballpoint pen). Before final submission of the written part of the exam, candidates must check if they signed it. Tests that are not signed will be considered invalid.

Questions are not allowed during the exam. If the candidates have questions, they will ask them upon the call of the exam committee.

Candidates may leave the exam venue only with the consent of the exam committee.

In case of violation of rules issued by the committee, the committee shall reserve the right to disqualify the candidate from the exam.
